Presented by the Potters Guild of Las Cruces

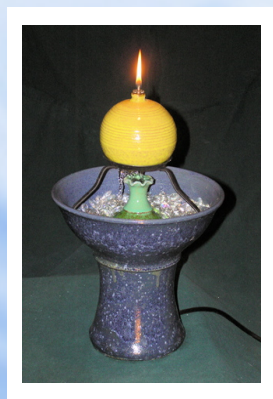
Location: NMSU Ceramics Studio, 120 Williams Hall
